

# Resolution #   9

WHEREAS: The Constitution and By-Laws of the Professional Firefighters Association of New Jersey, IAFF, AFL-CIO-CLC in Article 4 Section 7 states that it association does not encourage nor condone the actions of any member who engages in providing the same or similar services for which he or she may be titled and accordingly compensated outside the regular location of employment, in another jurisdiction, as a part time, per diem, per call or stipend compensated fire, rescue, emergency medical services or related agency where full time or regular scheduled and compensated professionals exist, and wherein such activity is being employed to reduce or eliminate the need for or work of union members and

WHEREAS: in the constitution and by-laws of the International Association of Fire Fighters it refers to "any" member and not "certain" member, therefore be it

RESOLVED: that the delegates assembled at the 68<sup>th</sup> Convention of the Professional Firefighters Association of New Jersey, IAFF, AFL-CIO-CLC held at Caesar's Hotel and Casino in Atlantic City, New Jersey, May 27<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup>, 2008, direct the elimination of Article 4 Section 7 of the PFANJ Constitution and By-laws and rely upon the IAFF Constitution and By-laws Article 15 Section E, which addresses this subject.
